

## **Storm Preparedness Checklist**

Gulf of Mexico hurricane season runs from June 1 to November 30. Taking action early and stocking up on storm prep essentials will help put your mind at ease — while helping to keep your family, pets and property safe.

Download and print your storm prep checklist to use while shopping and planning.

Vehicle	Important documents
Act as soon as a severe weather warning is issued.	Secure your documents in a waterproof bag.
□ Fill gas tank	<ul> <li>Photo IDs (driver's license, passports, social security cards)</li> </ul>
Check spare tire	Personal records (birth, marriage, wills)
Water, food and medication	<ul> <li>Medical records (prescriptions, insurance cards, healthcare providers)</li> </ul>
	□ Financial information (bank, debit and credit cards)
Ensure you have a 7-day supply for each person and pet.	<ul> <li>Property information (leases, mortgages, deeds, insurance, auto records)</li> </ul>
□ Non-perishable food	Family photos and keepsakes
Hand-operated can opener	<ul> <li>Important contact information (family, friends, work, schools, doctors)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Plastic utensils, cups and plates</li> <li>Pet food</li> </ul>	□ Utility bills or mail (to show proof of residence)

Regularly used medications	Cash Cash
□ First aid kit	
Toolkit	Get cash in case banks are closed or stores can't process debit and credit cards.
Basic toolkit, plus:	House
□ Flashlights for each family member	
Extra batteries	Plywood windows
□ Waterproof matches or lighter	□ Sand bags for exterior doors
Duct tape	Turn off propane tanks
□ Tarp	□ Have an extra set of house keys
□ Rope	□ Bring outdoor furniture indoors
	□ Listen to the radio or TV for important information
Communication	<ul> <li>Fill the bathtub with water to use for flushing the toilet</li> <li>Fill coolers with ice</li> </ul>

□ Make & distribute a family emergency plan	
Battery powered or hand-cranked AM/FM radio or NOAA Weather radio
