I wish the next president the best, and I offer my assistance if he or she needs it.

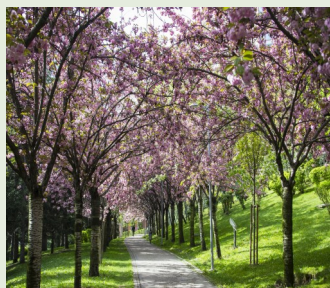

By placing your container in street, you are obstructing the street and causing drivers to swerve.
