Elections & Voting 101: Plan to Vote & Vote Early

Early voting starts February 20th - March 1, 2024

Primary voting: March 5, 2024.

Voting early is convenient and it reduces long lines on election day. Check your eligibility to vote. You are required to be eligible already to vote in the upcoming Primary. You can vote in a voting center near where you live or at any polling location. You can also vote by mail if you are eligible to do so. The deadline to apply for an absentee ballot is February 23, 2024.

You can find polling locations and hours, view sample ballots, check ID requirements at Harrisvotes.com or on the 311 City of Houston app. You can find additional voter information on the Civic Club website.
