WHAT CONTESTS WILL BE ON THE JUNE 15, 2024 BALLOT?

Voters registered in Harris County will see runoff contests for Place 2 and Place 3 of the Harris Central Appraisal District (HCAD) Board of Directors after no candidate received more than 50% of the votes in those contests during the May 4, 2024, election.
